

YDP Performance Series Costume Guide 2025

Welcome to the YDP Performance Series 2025! As you know from reading the <u>Performance Packet</u>, most of our classes source costume pieces from home. Some classes may receive accessories distributed in advance (dancers may keep these after the performance), while other costume pieces are "rentals" from our costume collection, which dancers will receive at the theater the day of the performance and return before the end of the show. Please check the chart in the second half of this document to see what your dancer is expected to source from home and what will be provided by the studio, noting that each level has a slightly different costuming system:

- **Creative Movement and Combo** faculty may provide tutus and/or bowties from the costume collection. These are considered rentals and will be distributed to dancers at the theater and collected by faculty after performance.
- Level 1-3 faculty have the option to order unique accessories that complement their vision to tie the costumes together. These will be distributed to families this spring and may be kept by dancers after the show. Faculty may also source costumes from the costume collection (rentals) for this age group. If they choose to do this, dancers will be sized in class and costumes will be distributed at the theater and returned before the end of the show.
- **Level 4-6** faculty have the option to source costume pieces from the costume collection. If they choose to do this, dancers will be sized in class and costumes will be distributed at the theater and returned before the end of the show.

Performance-related fees

Performance fee: Dancers in all performing classes were auto-charged a performance/costume fee of \$15 per class at the beginning of April. These fees pay for the administrative time retrieving, sizing, tracking, and logging costumes from our collection; the cost and tax for new accessories ordered online; and the long-term replacement costs for costumes as they wear out over time.

Replacement fees: All costumes rented from the costume collection must be returned to the designated costume coordinator at the end of the performance. Our costume coordinator will be backstage each show, working to ensure that all costumes are maintained and collected from dancers after they perform, but it is ultimately the dancer/family's responsibility to ensure that costumes get back to us. *Costume pieces rented from eXit SPACE that are lost before/during/after a show, returned late, or returned damaged will result in a \$50 replacement fee.*

Resources & reminders for stage readiness

In-Studio Dress Rehearsal Week: April 28 – May 3 is our designated in-studio Dress Rehearsal week when dancers wear their costumes to class for a final costume check-in. On this week, dancers should plan to arrive 5-10 minutes early for class with their hair done, makeup applied (if applicable), and either in costume (if it's entirely sourced from home) or wearing the necessary base layers (such as a leotard/tights) to put their costume pieces on quickly and modestly in the studio. Don't forget performance footwear! Please note that PROGRAM dancers are exempt from hair/makeup requirements during Dress Rehearsal Week due to the number of back-to-back classes they have each day and their advanced preparedness from countless performances earlier in the season.

Makeup: Stage makeup is highly recommended for dancers in levels 2+. Please note: we do *not* recommend dropping the lower eyeliner line down below the eye. Our theater is very small and the audience will be close to the dancers, so this is not necessary. Hair: If teachers have requested for hair to be pulled back, it must be pulled back cleanly. Please use hairspray and/or gel to minimize "wispies" on stage. For buns, see the ballet bun tutorials attached at the end of this season's <u>Dress Code</u> document.

Tights: Please refer to the costume chart below for more information on tights. For dancers wearing tights and a leotard, please remember: your tights are your underwear! Dancers of all ages should *not wear underwear under their leotards* as it peeks out and looks unprofessional on stage.

Shoes/socks: Every year, we have dancers forget footwear. Please know which shoes your dancer needs, noting that some classes require multiple types.

Performance day costume expectations: Dancers are expected to arrive at the theater with their hair done and makeup applied (if applicable) as outlined in their class' costume guidelines. They should either be entirely in costume if they had all of the pieces at home, or arrive wearing the necessary undergarments/base layers (such as a leotard, tights, etc.) under their street clothes so that they can quickly and easily change into their costume pieces at the theater. Dancer performing in multiple pieces in one show should arrive in the *first* costume they will be wearing on stage. Reminder: No dance shoes on the sidewalk! Arrive in outdoor footwear and change into dance shoes at the theater.

Creative Movement (all sections)	Costume piece(s) provided by dancer: [Option A] Leotard (any color, solid color preferred; no attached skirts) with pink/bronze/brown flesh-toned footed tights OR [Option B] Black leggings with a white fitted t-shirt or leotard
	Rental (distributed & collected at the theater): Matching tutus, bowties, and hair pieces
	Footwear provided by dancer: Pink or brown ballet shoes (to match dancer's skin tone tights) & black tap shoes. No socks for dancers wearing tights. If dancers in leggings must wear socks with tap shoes, they must be black or flesh-toned ankle socks.
	Hair: Long hair pulled back into a clean ballet bun; hair too short pulled back half up/down, into a ponytail, or clipped back depending on length.
	Makeup: Makeup not required; lipstick and blush will brighten faces!
	Costume piece(s) provided by dancer: [Option A]: White leotard (no attached skirt) with pink/bronze/brown flesh-toned footed tights (color must match dancer's skin tone) OR [Option B]: Black leggings with a white fitted t-shirt or leotard
	Rental (distributed & collected at the theater): Matching tutus, bowties, and hair pieces
Combo (all sections)	Footwear provided by dancer: Pink or brown ballet shoes (to match dancer's skin tone tights) & black tap shoes. No socks for dancers wearing tights. If dancers in leggings must wear socks with tap shoes, they must be black or flesh-toned ankle socks.
	Hair : Long hair pulled back into a clean ballet bun; hair too short pulled back half up/down, into a ponytail, or clipped back depending on length
	Makeup: Makeup not required; lipstick and blush will brighten faces!
	Costume piece(s) provided by dancer: Undergarments
	Rental (distributed & collected at the theater): Bronze high neck dress
