Produced by eXit SPACE | NOD Theater, the BOOST Dance Festival is an annual opportunity for Seattle contemporary dance artists who are both emerging and veteran dance-makers to present work alongside one another for an ever-broadening audience. BOOST is known for its party-like atmosphere where festival producers encourage dialogue amongst patrons between dance works as well as audible support during the show for the artists being presented. The atmosphere is uniquely curated to center the joy of live art, new dance, and community living at the heart of the experience.

BOOST is committed to the ongoing development of the Seattle dance community, curation of new dance works, and representation of diverse artists who reflect our whole community and city. Marlo Martin (BOOST Producer) is committed to an equitable application process and strives to select a wide range of artists and choreographers in terms of ethnicity, race, gender, and sexual orientation. This year, BOOST returns to its home at eXit SPACE | NOD Theater in Capitol Hill, Seattle, for its 10th season on **March 14-16, 2025.**

BOOST DETAILS & REQUIREMENTS

- Length of Work: 8-12 minutes, any genre
- **Complimentary rehearsal space:** Selected artists receive 10 hours of free rehearsal space at eXit SPACE studios, with the choice between theNEST (Green Lake), Studio SEA (Green Lake), and NOD Theater (Capitol Hill)
- **Pre-production meeting:** BOOST artists are required to participate in one 1-1.5 hour pre-production meeting during the month of March
- Tech & dress: Tech and dress rehearsals will take place Wednesday and Thursday, March 12 & 13 between 4:30-10pm (details TBA); all artists must be available during these times.
- **Performance:** Five BOOSTartists will present work at a fully produced performance series at eXit SPACE | NOD Theater, March 14-16, 2025
- Choreography stipend: Choreographers receive a \$650 BOOST Artist Stipend
- **Community engagement:** All selected artists are asked to uplift the BOOST program and eXit SPACE | NOD Theater within the greater community

ELIGIBILITY

- Applying choreographers must be residents of Washington and over the age of 18.
- BOOST is designed for established *and* emerging dance artists!
